The 8th China-EU Life Science Forum

Opening in Changsha



On July 11, the 8th China-EU Life Sciences Forum, with the theme of "Openness-Trust-Cooperation-Development", opened in Changsha. Zhou Honghao, academician of the Chinese Academy of Engineering, delivered a keynote speech entitled "Health Management and Industrial Opportunities Based on Individualized Medicine". He pointed out that the future development of individualized medicine requires conducting high-quality, large-sample clinical trials to confirm the genotype-phenotype correlation; improving the ability to identify pathogenic, rare, benign, and basic genetic variations; and constructing a complete genomic structure of common major diseases. He suggested integrating genetic test results into electronic medical records and automatically generating clinical decision programs with genotype-phenotype databases.

At the meeting, four European experts in the field of life sciences, including Dr. Jan-Christer Janson, a member of the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences and an international expert in bioseparation science and technology, also shared their keynote reports. Wang Guushu, Secretary of the Party Group and Executive Vice Chairman of Hunan Association for Science and Technology, said that Hunan Association for Science and Technology is constantly exploring the mode of overseas intellectual service for Hunan. And in the future, it will strengthen the exchanges and cooperation between Hunan Province and overseas scientific technological groups and overseas scientific and technological talents by building Haiji bases and employing Haiji experts, etc., so as to contribute to the building of Hunan as a scientific and technological innovation highland with core competitiveness.
